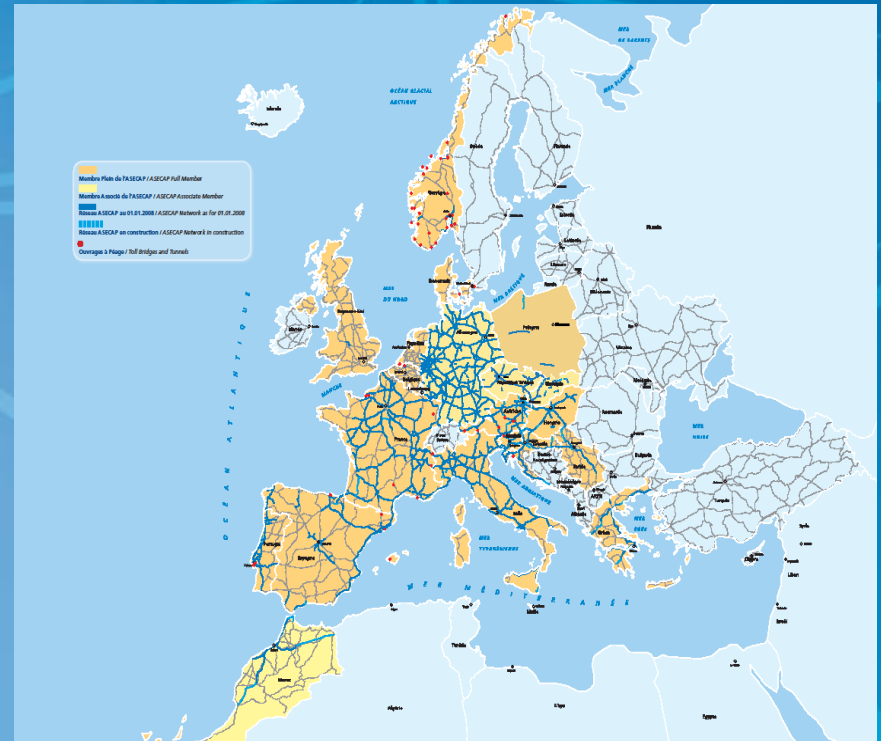

ASECAP Short Presentation

- ASECAP – Association Européenne des Concessionnaires d'Autoroutes et d'Ouvrages à Péage
 - 135 Members from 20 countries operating over :
 - 41.000 km of motorways
 - 14.000 manual toll lanes
 - 14.200 ETC lanes
 - 16.7 million ETC subscribers
 - Revenues over 22.7 Bn Euros per year
 - Stands for the payment of the infrastructures by those using them



ASECAP in EASYWAY

EASYWAY must establish a coordinated

- **top down political** approach and
- **bottom up technical** approach

in order to promote a “result oriented” ITS management, respecting

- a) the **maturity** of the industry as a whole and
- b) the **readiness** of EU regions to act.

ASECAP in EASYWAY

- active involvement of the **EU Member States** and all the **relevant stakeholders**.
- EASYWAY and ASECAP have signed an **MoU** aimed at the establishment of a well **regulated cooperation** between both sides.

ASECAP in EASYWAY

Based on the MoU of 2009

EASYWAY and ASECAP would create

- permanent vehicles-structures
- the needed task forces
- on specific issues

Main Domains of actions

- RTTI (Real-time Travel and Traffic Information), TMC (Traffic Management and Control), Cooperative Systems

Complementary Domains

- Scheduling of coordinated measures, dissemination
